

UNDERSTANDING THE FULL PICTURE

INSTRUCTIONS:

Participants are split into groups (Group size depends on number of pieces the picture is cut up into. Each member of a group is given a cut up of the picture to study for 10 seconds.

After 10 seconds, members will re-group and will attempt to recreate the picture by drawing it out. Only one person is allowed to draw, while others will give inputs. After 5 minutes, members will be given another 10 seconds to view their piece of the cut up again.

The first team who successfully re-creates the picture wins!

LEARNING POINTS:

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Participants have to learn to receive and process information from various sources in order to form a coherent understanding of the picture. Neglecting any source (or input from member) will lead to an incomplete picture.
